### **CO Alarms Mandatory In All Homes**

The Ontario Fire Code requires that carbon monoxide detectors be placed/installed near all sleeping areas in residential homes and in the service rooms and adjacent sleeping areas in multi-residential units. Carbon monoxide alarms can be hard wired, battery operated or plugged into the wall. All residents are reminded that the six month implementation period expired on April 15, 2015.
