Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Launches 2025 Asset Management Level of Service Survey

Northern Bruce Peninsula, ON – The Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula is inviting residents and stakeholders to participate in the 2025 Asset Management Level of Service Survey. This important initiative will help the Municipality assess current service levels and guide future investments in infrastructure, ensuring the long-term sustainability and efficiency of municipal assets.

Why This Survey Matters

Municipal assets—such as roads, bridges, drinking water, wastewater, stormwater systems, and facilities—play a critical role in supporting the daily lives of residents and businesses. Understanding community expectations and service priorities will help the Municipality make informed decisions on maintenance, upgrades, and long-term planning.

Provincial Requirements

Under Ontario Regulation 588/17: Asset Management Planning for Municipal Infrastructure, all municipalities must develop and maintain an Asset Management Plan that outlines current service levels, anticipated future demands, and financial strategies to manage municipal assets efficiently. The regulation sets clear milestones, including the requirement for municipalities to define Levels of Service (LOS) for core infrastructure by July 1, 2025. This survey will help the Municipality meet these requirements by collecting valuable public input on service priorities, concerns, and expectations.

The 2025 Asset Management Level of Service Survey is available online at letstalknbp.ca and paper copies can be obtained at the Municipal Office. The survey will remain open until March 31st, 2025.

Mayor McIver emphasized the importance of community participation: “Infrastructure investment decisions impact everyone. Your feedback will help us shape future projects and ensure that our asset management strategies align with the needs and expectations of our residents.”
